

## CrossPointe student records online

The CrossPointe Student Records OnLine™ module satisfies all the information needs of everyone in your district: school administrators can evaluate their student populations, allocate resources, and consolidate data for accurate State reporting; teachers can work with attendance, grades, conduct, and homework; counselors can build schedules; district superintendents can communicate with their staff, school board, or the community; and parents/students can check quiz/test grades, class attendance, homework or graduation plans. The district is provided with consolidated access to all student information, while individual schools have a granular view allowing them to manage each individual student record. This multi-level design allows the schools to work at a detailed level while giving the district the ability to float between the detail and summary view of the students. District administrators and school personnel have complete, real-time student information for effectively managing the district and school. Parents and students have web access to all the information they need to be successful, such as daily grades, test dates/scores, homework assignments, period-by-period attendance, and school activities.

### demographics

The demographics component of this module is used to define and track the student population. The detailed student data maintained in this component ranges from enrollment history and contact information to immunization status and food service participation. Student movement is also tracked within and in/out of the district. The tracking of bus routes and their associated stops and assigned students are available as well as the printing of transportation rosters and mass maintenance.

### scheduling

Our scheduling component has been designed with the flexibility to handle the many different types of scheduling methodologies. Our reliable and highly accurate scheduling tools allow schools to successfully schedule large numbers of students with little or no manual entry. These same tools can be used to schedule teams of students or individual students who arrive after the scheduling process is completed. The Admissions component is used within reassignment to schedule students for the next school year without affecting their current scheduling. Applications for various programs can also be managed efficiently.

### attendance

The attendance component is a full-featured solution for tracking student attendance. With this component, each school has the ability to easily record student attendance using district-defined codes that can be set-up for daily and by-period attendance. District administrators can get real-time access to attendance data for school-by-school or year-by-year analysis. With this real-time view, district administrators are better able to respond to all attendance issues.

### grade reporting

Our grade reporting component gives the district the ability to track a student's academic achievement from kindergarten through graduation. With the ability to create custom skill sets for primary grades, custom grading scales and weighting schemes for secondary grades, the district has complete control over how the grades are represented across the district. With this component you can also generate multiple GPA types and associate the grading results to a student's graduation plan.



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## **conduct**

The conduct component allows the district to track notable situations in which students are involved. Everything from disciplinary events to Good Samaritan events can be tracked on this flexible system. Each conduct event can have an unlimited number of incidents and an unlimited number of responses to those incidents. It also has the ability to tie an unlimited number of students to that event, giving the district a quick and detailed method of tracking different student conduct events with no data duplication or loss of detail.

## **special programs**

The special programs component is designed to simplify the tracking of students participating in federal, state, or local special programs while increasing the accuracy of the data. Schools can go online to view the students who have been evaluated for special programs that have not already been staffed. These and other tools help ensure accurate reporting for all of the programs.

## **health**

The Health component provides a comprehensive information management tool, which serves both district and school-level personnel. On-line panels capture required immunization and medical examination information as required for school entry. Districts may choose to use a variety of optional facilities to log visits to the clinic, keep track of medication records, monitor health screenings, and track referrals to external health agencies.

## **activities and fees**

The Activities and Fees component provides a tool for school-level personnel to track students' participation in extra curricular activities, receipt of scholarships, community service hours, etc. The fee-tracking portion of this component may be used to record payment of fees such as a yearbook, library or parking fines, locker fees, etc. All activity and fee codes are locally defined at the district level to provide consistency when a student transfers from one school to another.

## **test scores**

The Test Scores component provides a tool for school-level personnel to maintain scores on standardized tests for individual students. This component may also be used to track standards mastered on state or local exams. All test identifiers are defined at the district level to provide consistency when a student transfers from one school to another. New tests can be defined at the district level as needed.

## **external reporting**

Our external reporting component is used to consolidate all student related data for state reporting. This component contains a powerful funding calculator to generate the consolidated data, while also supplying online access for adjustments to the data. This component has been designed with state reporting in mind. New state reporting requirements can be easily implemented with little or no impact to the individual schools in the district.

## **parent/student access**

The parent/student access component provides secure Internet access to attendance, grades, conduct, homework, teachers, and much more. With the parent/student access component, parents will not only be informed about their child's progress in school, but also have access to a wealth of information for enriching their family's life.
