CrossPointe Financial Information OnLine™ was specifically designed to help schools manage their finances. It efficiently processes all the financial transactions needed by public school districts and provides up-to-the-minute financial information to schools and the district office.

general ledger/financial reporting

The General Ledger/Financial Reporting module serves as the backbone for the system. It provides for definition and maintenance of the chart of accounts, creation and posting of all types of financial transactions, and comprehensive reporting for both regularly-scheduled and ad-hoc information retrieval using interactive as well as batch (printed) facilities.

budget management

The Budget Management module allows the district to develop a budget for the new fiscal year and monitor the budget status (available balance) for the current fiscal year. It aids in the development of the new fiscal year budget by pulling information from CrossPointe Human Resources OnLine™ and making historical information available online to those responsible for budget preparation. It aids in the monitoring of budget status by allowing for both summary and detailed account information to be made available online.

purchasing

The Purchasing module controls the authorization of expenditures by the school district. This module allows for schools/departments to request goods and services online, allows for review/approval of those goods/services by the purchasing department, and allows for the printing of approved requisitions as Purchase Orders.

accounts payable

The Accounts Payable module controls all cash disbursements to the district's vendors. It facilitates invoice entry and the payment of those invoices based on receipt of goods and services. The module is also capable of processing and generating both paper and electronic 1099's.

bid preparation

The Bid Preparation module is used for the creation and processing of bids. Both online and batch facilities allow school districts to aggregate their purchasing to increase their buying power.
